

2012 JSGS POSTER COMPETITION

Poster Guidelines

1. Your poster should be 3 feet by 3 feet.
2. Include a poster title and information identifying the researcher(s) on your poster. Please follow template provided.
3. The title should be large and clear to be read from approximately 4 meters away.
4. Title should be short and letters should be bold. Do not use all upper case letters.
5. Your poster should be eye-catching and attractive.
6. Keep it simple, do not clutter, do not include unnecessary data, and use bold and large font.
7. Displayed materials should be self-explanatory, freeing you for discussion.
8. Make sure figures and photographs are of high quality.
9. Labels and arrows should be bold and easily seen.
10. Colors should be used to emphasize and add interest. Be mindful of color choices, as some color combinations can hinder readability.
11. Posters must be submitted by email in PDF format to Annette.Marche@uregina.ca by April 4, 2012.
12. To reduce compatibility issues, we will accept submissions using Adobe Acrobat (not Adobe Flash). Please avoid developing presentations on McIntosh Apple computers .

Abstract

1. Should be informative and 250 words or less.
2. Include title and researchers(s) identity.
3. Abstracts must be submitted by email in PDF format to Annette.Marche@uregina.ca no less than 15 working days prior to competition.

Poster Competition Requirements

1. Presenters are required to come early to set up posters.
2. Easels will be provided for displaying poster.
3. JSGS will arrange mounting of posters in advance and will transport posters to venue.
4. Presenters are required to stand by posters during competition for discussion and questions.
