=


Quantity of services \* price of services


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
"Providers" \* income of providers


## Bending the cost curve is not the only objective!


#### Total and government per capita health care spending, Canada and BC, constant \$ (\$2011), 1975-2011



















#### BC's attempt to bend the cost curve ("key results areas")


- Effective health promotion and prevention
- High quality hospital services
- Integrated primary and community care
  - Focus on groups with high average use
  - Try to avoid / delay high-cost services, e.g. acute care, long-term care (nursing homes)
  - [not expanding acute and long-term care infrastructure]



#### Percentage distribution of BC population by population segments, 2002/03 and 2008/09





#### Total and per capita spending by population segment, BC, 2008/09





#### Expenditures per capita by local health area, high complex chronic condition population segment, age 75+, 2008/09




