- 1944-1964: Co-operative Commonwealth Federation (CCF)
- 1964-1971: Liberal
- 1971-1982: New Democratic Party
- 1982-1991: Progressive Conservative
- 1991-2007: New Democratic Party
- 2007-XXXX: Saskatchewan Party
