To be eligible for this competition you must:

<input type="radio"/> your research must involve and benefit Indigenous Communities
<input type="radio"/> be registered at the University of Regina, First Nations University of Canada, University of Saskatchewan, or Saskatchewan Polytechnic Student (Masters, PhD, or PostDoc)
<input type="radio"/> have a minimum GPA of 75%
<input type="radio"/> may be at any stage of your academic program, but must maintain a 75% GPA each and every semester over the course of the award; failure to do so will cause the award to be canceled
<input type="radio"/> you must be registered full time by the first week of each semester (Fall and Winter) ; you may be registered part time or full time for the Spring/Summer semester
<input type="radio"/> preference will be given to fully eligible Indigenous applicants (supporting documentation will be required as proof of Indigeneity)
<input type="radio"/> students who are currently being paid with Tri-Council funding up to August 31, 2020 are not eligible for this funding

The values for each award are as follows:

- **PhD: \$30,000** for 1 year
- **Master's: \$20,000** for a year
- **Post Doctoral Fellows: \$70,000** for a year

* All awards have the possibility of being renewed for a second year.
